Common Florida Mandatory Course Package Questions:

QUESTION: Does 4CEUINC report to Florida's CE Broker?

ANSWER: YES. We report to CE Broker immediately after course completion of online courses provided that your license # is in your profile at the time of course completion. We report under CEB# 50-2256.



QUESTION: Is this the correct course if I am applying for a NEW Florida Lab license?

ANSWER: NO. When applying for a NEW Florida license, order the Florida Initial Licensure Package, course code: F1021.

QUESTION: Is this the correct course if I am renewing an existing Florida Lab license?

ANSWER: NO. If you already have a FL Lab license, order the Florida Mandatory Course Package, course code: FM021.

QUESTION: Do I have to take Florida Mandatory courses EACH license cycle to renew my Florida Lab License?

ANSWER: YES. Starting with your first FULL renewal cycle, you will be required to take all 3 Florida Mandatory courses EACH license cycle in order to renew your Florida Lab License. Mandatory courses are part of the required 24 CE hours.
