Understanding the Course Formats:

Online Complete



With the Online Complete format, the purchaser receives the reading material in an online document – typically a PDF file – and an online quiz. One copy of the document can be printed out or can be saved to a flash drive to be shared with coworkers or saved for future reference. Remember to save a copy of the document **before** completing the quiz.

Online Quiz Only



With the Online Quiz Only format, the purchaser only receives access to the online quiz. You must have access to the reading material, either through a coworker, your employer, or you can purchase the 'printed book only' option to pair with the online quiz. Most people print out a copy of the quiz & work offline, before entering their answers in the live quiz.

Printed Book Only



Printed Books are **no longer available** for this FL Histo. Combo Course. *

This course consists of an online PDF file. Once purchased, you are entitled to print 1 copy of each PDF file if you prefer to have a printed copy.

Answer Sheet Only



With the Answer Sheet Only format, the purchaser will receive a printable Answer Sheet which can be faxed back to our office or uploaded into your online profile. **Changes:** 1.) YOU will print your Answer Sheets from your "My Courses" list – this will allow you to reprint the sheets as needed. 2.) YOU will print your Certificate from your "Course History" list.

QUESTION: Do you still offer a Printed Book for Histology?
